D-Cinema DCP Entry Guide

This document describes how to send a Digital Cinema Package for your film's screening.

How does it work?

DOK Leipzig accepts DCI compliant Digital Cinema Packages (DCP) for screening. We suggest to commission a professional service provider to create the DCPs to ensure standard compliance. Please don't send untested DCPs that never got approval by a DCP mastering facility or a successful screening on a D-Cinema server.

	be issued for all screens, starting 4 weeks prior festival.
