

Mit der Dunkelheit kommt die Angst, mit der Angst schwindet das Licht. Bei einem gemeinsamen Tauchgang steigen in „ihm“ versunkene Erinnerungen auf. Wie bei der Verlandung, beim „Faulen“ des Sees wird der Freiraum des Wassers zum Sumpf. Die wachsende Beklemmung beschleunigt den Atem im Rhythmus der intensiver werdenden lyrischen Sprache. Die Kraft der Strudel und der expressiven schweizerdeutschen Laute färben und formen die bestechend grafische Sandanimation.

— *With darkness comes fear, and with fear the light disappears. During a dive together, sunken memories rise in “him”. And just like the process of sedimentation, when the lake “rots”, the open water becomes a swamp. Growing anxiety accelerates the breath to the rhythm of the increasingly intense lyrical language. Meanwhile the power of the vortices and expressive Swiss-German tone serve to tint and shape this captivatingly graphical sand animation.* André Eckardt
