

# Her Name Is Fields

Two young artists spiral into drug addiction. This is a story about the struggle to set boundaries when we love.

Through the spiral of addiction Pola and Kuba start as a young artistic couple in love, but their fascination with morphine quickly turns into a destructive spiral. Addiction takes control over their lives, and their relationship becomes a toxic codependency. They isolate themselves from the world, neglecting relationships and work, which leads them to sink deeper into manipulation and emotional abuse. The turning point in their relationship comes when Pola becomes pregnant. Fearing her future, she decides to have an abortion in Germany. For Pola, this becomes her moment of awakening, so she decides to leave Kuba. For Kuba, the loss deepens his depression and addiction. His journey toward recovery becomes a difficult and painful process.

Parallel to this unfolds the story of Martyna, the cinematographer and director, who has been recording their lives for the past 4 years. Gradually, Martyna realises how she has entangled herself in the protagonist's story. Is her mission to save Kuba and Pola, or is she trying to save herself? Healing requires looking back. Martyna must confront the moments where she sacrificed her own needs for Pola, when her life was consumed by her best friend's chaos and crisis. We witness Martyna slowly rediscover herself, beyond the role of a rescuer. She learns to set boundaries as she reckons with the past. It's here that the film takes a universal dimension — it is a story about all of us — how close relations can be a source of strength as well as a trap, from which we can't break free.

# **Inner Wild**

As a child, Karin dreamed of escaping her strict middle-class household for a wilder life. As an adult, she chases her dreams to the farthest end of Europe, where she uncovers the true cost of freedom.

Ever since she was a little girl. Karin dreamed of living on her own terms. Born in 1960 in East Germany, she was raised in a typical middle-class family. Her responsibilities were to be polite, respectful and tidy. From a young age, she felt an urge to escape from her domineering mother and the rigid framework that she was forced to conform to. Then came the explosion in Chernobyl in 1986. For Karin, this catastrophic event gave her the reason she needed to run away and find sanctuary in the wilderness. Thirty years on, Karin has made a life for herself in Portugal, carving out a slice of wonder for herself in the natural landscape. She makes do on her own, with no electricity or running water. She has achieved everything she ever wanted: freedom, wildlife, agricultural labor, a connection to the Earth and it's creatures. Yet she also finds there is a hefty price to pay for this trade-off. Karin lives a solitary life. Her children have grown up and they refuse to accept her 'wild' lifestyle. They've opted for stability and order in the city instead. Each day, she puts in a Sisyphean effort to defend her values and the life she's chosen. Some people may think of Karin as a misfit, an outsider. Those who truly know her are touched by her sensitivity, resilience, generosity and her inner wild.

# **Love Letters**

In a world that's constantly changing, one thing remains: the desire to love and be loved. A journey through the letters sent to Juliet in Verona — past and present — reveals what time does (and doesn't) do to the heart.

In Verona, the romantic heart of Italy and the legendary setting of *Romeo* and Juliet, thousands of letters arrive each year addressed to Juliet Capulet. Some are handwritten, others emailed — sent by those seeking advice, comfort, or simply a witness to their emotions. These letters come from all over the world and are answered with care by volunteers at the Juliet Club, a unique organization that has turned anonymous cries for love into an extraordinary collective ritual of empathy.

At the center of this delicate ecosystem is Giovanna, the long-time head of the Juliet Club. A modern-day guardian of love stories, Giovanna has spent decades organizing volunteers, archiving letters, and preserving one of the most touching literary correspondences of our time. In *Love Letters*, she becomes our guide. In a moving and cinematic journey, we follow Giovanna as she travels across the globe to meet some of the most unforgettable letter writers from the Club's vast archive. Together, we revisit the emotions that once compelled them to write: young love, heartbreak, infidelity, longing.




Mateusz Wajda

# Maestra

Maestra is a documentary film telling the story of Lidia Grychtołówna — the grand dame of Polish piano music.

For over 90 years, the piano has been her daily companion. Now, she faces perhaps her most profound challenge — confronting old age and saying goodbye to the stage. This film is a true boxing ring, where passion fights against the effects of aging, with Chopin and Schumann as the timekeepers. For decades, Lidia performed alongside great artists such as Rubinstein, Michelangeli, Chaczaturiann giving concerts all over the world. She is a strong, charismatic protagonist who dedicated her entire professional life to one thing: playing the piano.

This is a tender, quietly powerful portrait of aging — but not a social drama, nor a conventional biopic — it's a rather funny comedy. Lidia never gives up, not even for a moment, and faces every obstacle with humor. In such moments, she often says: 'Nothing can knock me down — they'll have to finish me off with a hammer.' The power of passion makes the impossible possible.

Grychtołówna gave her farewell concert at the age of 96, becoming the oldest performing concert pianist in the world. But this is not the end — a new adventure awaits her, this time connected to the 19th International Fryderyk Chopin Piano Competition.

# Sugarland

The people of Chiapas, Mexico's poorest state, drink the most Coca-Cola in the world — more than 2 litres per person per day. How did this happen? The Polish and Mexican team is investigating this question on film.

Coca-Cola is extremely important to the people of Chiapas — it is used ritually during prayers in church, it determines a person's status, and if a local politician wants to win the people's vote, he or she has to serve 180 cases of Coke at a rally. What's more, local healers (curanderos) believe in the healing power of Coca-Cola. There is an epidemic of diabetes and obesity in Chiapas, while at the same time the Coca-Cola plants are depleting the groundwater, leaving residents without access to drinking water. The indigenous community is aware of the problem, but has no means of stopping 'coca colonisation'.

Ola, a journalist with a Polish team, and Joel, an indigenous artist with a Mexican team, go to the source of the problem to find out how Chiapas has become the world's biggest consumer of Coca-Cola. Along the way, they discuss how their interviewees are treated and the answers they get — are the differences related to their background and skin colour? Will the investigation give Joel the tools to get Coca-Cola out of the stores in his community and allow Ola to understand why it has captured Mexican souls?

# **Tickling the Devil**

After years spent in a world of violence, a celebrated American war photographer tries to find meaning in life at home with his loved ones. His inner demons prevent him from regaining balance.

Christopher Morris, a photojournalist for Time magazine and winner of 20 World Press Photo awards, has spent decades documenting the horrors of war. Now, far from the frontlines, he lives with his wife and daughters in the seemingly perfect suburbs of Tampa — but peace still eludes him. Suffering from post-traumatic stress disorder, Chris is constantly triggered by symbols that awaken memories he cannot escape. Only the love and presence of his family keep him grounded. After returning from war, he barricaded the door to his personal archive, afraid of what confronting the past might unleash. Yet the deeper he looks at an increasingly polarized and violent America, the more unsettlingly familiar it begins to feel. The film is an intimate portrait of a man shaped by conflict — external and internal. It explores the emotional toll of bearing witness, the lingering effects of trauma, and the struggle to make sense of a country in crisis. At its heart is Chris's relationship with Vesna, a woman he met during the Bosnian war, who gave him a home, a family, and a chance at healing. Through her love, he found refuge from the darkest parts of himself. But as Chris turns his lens toward the fractures of a conflict-ridden America, his greatest fear is not about the past, but about the future. Can he protect what he loves — and find peace within a world that feels on the brink?

# What a Coincidence?

In a world where millions of people search for love, sex, and friendship through dating apps, many find themselves trapped in recurring psychological patterns. These patterns, often shaped by the subconscious and intergenerational trauma, dictate our choice of partners.

What a Coincidence? explores this complex web of influences through the lives of its main character: Olga, her mother Danuta, and her niece Klaudia. Tired of repeating the same cycles, Olga embarks on a transformative journey through various therapies and self-development practices.

through various therapies and self-development practices.

The narrative spans three generations of women from the same family, all struggling to find lasting relationships due to inherited trauma. Starting with a great-grandmother forced into an unwanted marriage more than a hundred years ago, the story reveals a pattern of destructive relationships passed down through the generations. The film follows Olga's attempt to break free from this cycle and to heal. But will the change last? And what stands in her way? The film is structured as a loop: the same stories return multiple times — each told from a different perspective. Each new relationship reactivates the same emotional patterns. The same type of men, the same situations lead Olga to a growing need for change and a deeper insight into the mechanisms that shape her life. The film captures a process unfolding both before her eyes and within her inner world, broadening a perspective that remains invisible to Olga herself, but which in truth shapes her actions.
